RESEARCH AND OTHER SCIENTIFIC WORK

Principal research work has revolved around the following sectors: Assessment of psychopathology in psychotic melancholia and schizophrenia of adults. Assessment of psychopathology in children and adolescents; epidemiological research and needs assessment in child psychiatry care services, studies of the consequences of AIDS in multi-transfused children. Assessment of psychosocial problems of Thalassaemia. Development of preventive intervention for the promotion of Child Mental Health and psychosocial development of children 0-2 years through primary health care workers. Characteristic topics investigated include: demographic and psychosocial features of children referred to psychiatric out-patient care; epidemiological and psychosocial features of children with a history of attempted suicide and of psychotic children; psychological features of parents who abuse and/or neglect their children; intervention models for AIDS families, psychosocial characteristics and pattern of adaptation of children and families with Thalassaemia, promotion of children's psychosocial development through primary Health Care Services, coping with physical illness with emphasis on blood dyscrasias. Research work in the area of mental health promotion for children under 5 years of age through implementation of interventions with Primary Health Care Personnel.
